Peter Van De Merwe; the greatest in Dutch pigeon sport

Wherever doors open and Peter Van De Merwe walks in the room, looks are focussed on the tall fancier from Dordrecht and voices whisper: ‘the champ is here’ ... it is the result of the most impressive hegemony in Dutch pigeon sport. In his first year as fancier in 1987 Peter directly became champion, to never leave the highest regions and winning an unbelievable number of 18x 1st NPO and many National acebird titles ... Peter excepts the new challenge of a new start with only 2014 bred youngsters, as in winter 2014 he shall end a legendary career by selling his total racing and breeding colony on PIPA in. An auction never shown before with 10x 1st NPO winners, many 1st prov. winners and mothers, brothers, sister children to top breeders like ‘Replay’, ‘Amigo’, ‘Gwen’, ‘Cocktail’, etc. ...

Just over 40 years old, Peter has a history of almost 30 years in pigeon racing behind him. Since his entrance in sport, he has been the exponent of a new generation young fanciers, willing to give total dedication and daring to be innovative. However the great strength of this gifted fancier, is he managed to preserve his family of successful pigeons over this entire period. Starting with unique quality birds and always keeping the best performers for stock – never selling the biggest champs – are major ingredients of a success-story never shown before in Dutch pigeon racing.

Amongst animals

In 1972 Peter Van De Merwe was born as oldest child of Arie and Plonie Van De Merwe, mason and housewife, living in the Rechter Zandweg neighbourhood Dubbeldam in Dordrecht. A cosy family where Peter had a warm home and grew up with his younger sister. In their spare time the Van De Merwe’s had a big passion; animals. Arie bred dressage horses at his parental house in the Noordendijk, Dordrecht. It was the gathering place for the family, where young Peter spend many hours helping his father and grandfather ...

but also helping his uncle Piet, who was pigeon fancier, by cleaning his loft regularly and watching the pigeons as they came home from races.

Behind the house in Dubbeldam, his parents made a nice aviary for Peter where he homed all kinds of animals; chickens, rabbits, turtle doves, etc. It was Peters favourite pastime to take care of his varied colony. Building shacks with friends or playing soccer after school time were not of his interest. Animals where his great love; those in the aviary at home and the horses and uncle Piet’s pigeons at the Noordendijk. At home he bred young rabbits and young chickens – bringing them up to beautiful young animals became a passion.

In the Van De Merwe family, all members helped each other. Because father Arie had to work and young Peter went to school, mother Plonie helped wherever needed, with the horses of course but also with the care for young rabbits or chickens bred by Peter. That will to help must have been moored in Peters genes, because more and more when he joined his father to the Noordendijk, he helped uncle Peter with his pigeons. Cleaning the breeders and youngsters became Peters main



task, but also after races he helped separating the hens from the cocks ... slowly Peters interest in pigeons grew and as 15 years old boy, he got his first pair of pigeons from uncle Piet, a black cock and a pied hen. Peter was on the road as pigeon fancier.

Success from the beginning

Peter started breeding with his pair of pigeons and uncle Piet gave him some extra youngsters occasionally ... By the end of 1986 he had about 20 pigeons in the aviary and all chickens, rabbits, et cetera had to make way for the new passion; racing pigeons. Peter was very much triggered by entering on races and at uncle Piet he had seen how 'the widowhood game' with cocks was played; that is what he wanted. His father built him a loft in the winter of 1986 and in 1987 Peter was ready for racing with 9 yearling widowhood cocks ... Peter showed to be an exceptional talent in pigeon sport. He entered the club the first week as 15-years old rookie and just a few months later he was crowned as 1st short distance champion in Dordrecht Fed. with 650 members ... this was something even the oldest most experienced fanciers had never seen before. They were convinced; a new phenomenon was born.

It was a start in pigeon racing characteristic for Peters further career; fanciers experienced one surprise after another. The young champ considered his strong base of pigeons as most important key to success. The absolute foundation is formed by two of the first pigeons he got from Piet and they were NL86-2126430 'De Zwarte 430' x NL85-1317092

'Oude Duivin Tournier'; a pair that combined the best Tournier x Janssen bloodlines, that made Piet Van De Merwe also to one of the leading names in pigeon racing. Direct children to 'Zwarte 430' x 'Oude Duivin Tournier' were tremendous racers and breeders. This base was responsible for a flying start and in the Nineties within a few years Peter had made many headlines winning a/o

In his first years of racing, Peter was the destined 1st youth champion of the province of South-Holland. On the annual award ceremony, Peter saw the absolute stars of the show were the De Wit brothers, with a super strain of Janssen and De Klak birds. In provincial racing they were the best senior members by far; from them Peter had to have

some reinforcements. In 1993 he used all his 'holiday pay' to buy 11 De Wit pigeons to cross to the inbred Janssen/Tourniers of uncle Piet. Amongst these 11 was a/o 'Super Breeder 048', one of the best breeders Peter ever had.

To the Noordendijk

After finishing his education at the age of 16, Peter had started his working life as carpenter. In the meanwhile the Van De Merwe family had moved to the Noordendijk to live in the parental house. Ideal for father Arie's horses and for Peter there was plenty of room now to built a bigger loft and house more pigeons. Peter managed the colony and mother Plonie took care of the breeders and youngsters in the morning ... later, when Arie's working days were over, he also helped more and more in pigeons and so the Van De Merwe transformed from 'horses-family' to 'pigeon-family' ... This full dedication paid out in fantastic results. Just before the century-change, Peter built a new

A perfect start

'Peter, can you take these strange pigeons and free them on the other side of Dordrecht?? They will return home than' ... these words of uncle Piet Van De Merwe were the indirect start of Peters career as fancier. The teenager took the strangers home to his aviary and informed uncle Piet he could not stand the thought of the birds not returning home and – secretly – he wanted to home some pigeons himself. "Start with some good ones than" Piet said and gave Peter a pair of breeders. Not much later, in his first season with 9 racing cocks, Peter became 1st short distance champion from 650 members.

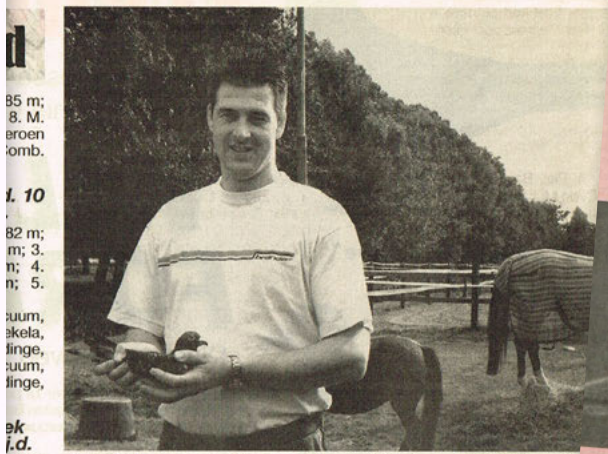

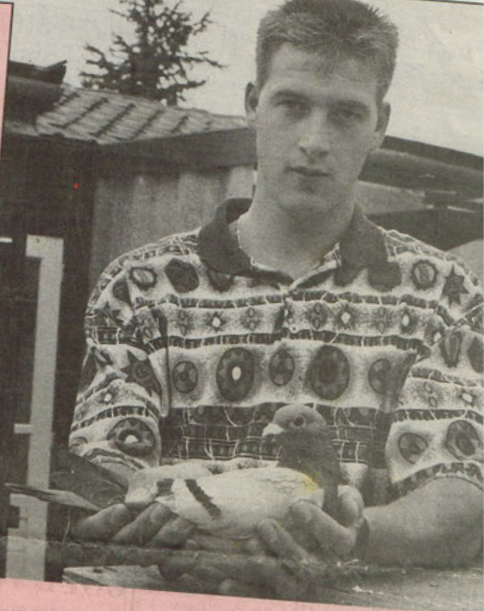

house for him to live with his partner Natalie on the Noordendijk-premises and when all was settled, just around 1999, it was time reap the fruits of a great location and a magnificent breeding colony.

In 1996 Peter had bought a bon for a couple eggs at grandmaster Louis Van Loon in Belgium. He knew many fanciers were successful with these super pigeons and managed to buy one extra couple of eggs ... it was one of the best investments Peter ever did. Two of the four eggs were 'Divoza' and 'Navita', who were paired to '891 Tournier' (himself winner 3x 1st prize) and '608 Tournier', two top sons of the base pair 'Zwarte 430' x 'Oude Duivin Tournier' ... It was a golden hit and these bloodlines bred a long list of super racers and breeders ... just a few of them are:

- 'Gwen'; 1st Nat. young acebird NPO 2001
- 'Yme'; winner 1st – 6,424 birds and 2nd – 2,828 birds
- 'Speedy'; 1st NPO Ruffec 6,150 birds
- 'Black 872'; Winner 3x 1st prize and mother 'Britt', 2x top 5 Nat. NPO
- 'Demi'; 3rd National youngster WHZB 2000
- 'Lorenzo'; Winner 4x 1st prize

The success of the first years at the Rechter Zandweg was perfected at the Noordendijk-premises. Where about 24 widowhood cocks, 40 youngsters and 6 breeding pairs were the limit at the old address, Peter now had plenty of room to home more racers and breeders. He also switched from classic widowhood system to total widowhood and hens were led

A legendary season

Perhaps the season 1991 was the most memorable of all ... Just 19 years of age, Peter was always a serious candidate to win against the biggest of birdages. Even though 'the big fishes' were mostly prey of the established champions, Peter winning the NPO race from Etampes against 27,698 birds did not come as a surprise. However repeating this master act winning 1. NPO Orleans 11,244 birds a few weeks later, really shocked the pigeon world. Winning two NPO victories and a car in one season; it is a booty that stays out of reach in the total careers of a majority of fanciers. For Peter Van De Merwe it was just the beginning.

to highlights just as easy as cocks ... Peter's skills were undisputed and the class of his pigeons recognised worldwide. Many fanciers from all over the globe found their way to the Van De Merwe residence and the entree of Van De Merwe pigeons meant a new level of performances for many of them ... it made Peter's strain one of the most appreciated in the world. Surely Peter's philosophy to sell the apples, but not the tree made him standing the teeth of time. All top performers became great value breeders and the dominance of Peter Van De Merwe kept on growing.

Close to perfection

In the new millennium highlights followed each other soon after each other. Naturally because of the development of the breeding colony being perfected time after time. Peter tested his breeders carefully and on a search for great new material he a/o succeeded at Jaap Ottevanger ('Cocktail' lines), Cees Van De Poel

(G. & C. Koopman lines), Ad Schaerlaeckens ('Favorietje' lines) and Verkerk ('Jacqueline' lines) ... but especially the individual reinforcement of 'Golden Eye' at B & W partnership was of essential influence. Paired to 'Super Breeder 048' (De Wit brothers) she created a very important dynasty of winners for Peter Van De Merwe, especially in the late Nineties – early new Millennium years. Most famous exponents of this top pair are:

- 'The Spike'; 2nd Nat. young acebird 2000
- 'Britt'; 2x top 5 NPO winner
- 'Ovita'; Winner of 3x 1st prize
- 'Lavita'; Winner 4x 1st prize & winner 3rd and 4th NPO

- 'Bauer', 1st Nat. acebird middle distance WENC 2003
- 'United', 2nd Nat. young acebird Best of The Best 2009
- 'Mona Lisa', 1st prov. Peronne 23,022 b.
- 'Shane', 1st NPO Argenton 10,432 b.



Pigeon sport at Van De Merwe had become a real family matter. Therefore his father and mother could be of great assistance when Peter had an accident at work and damaged his back that seriously, he had to quit his job as carpenter. Physical strain in work was no longer reserved for Peter and he had to change from an active to an office job. In this – also mental – difficult period, Peters family and his pigeons pulled him through.

As young Gwen grew, she was also a frequent guest in the lofts, helping grandpa, granny or Peter nursing the pigeons. In the footsteps of her father, she too got a small group of young and old birds to take care of at a very young age. Of course from the super breeding pairs of her father, so listing top performances was to be expected. On occasions Gwen already beats her father nowadays and also wins in massive competition ... and just like her father she's fond of a variety of animals, also horses and rabbits have her interest ... so many resemblances, who knows whereto that may lead!

Modern base cock "Replay"

Peter Van De Merwe was on top of his fame and in pigeon world all knew to hold their breath when the battle for the big prizes began. Many top fanciers wanted a piece of the success and proposed to exchange youngsters. On many occasions this was a disappointment for one or both parties, however with Marcel Sangers the exchange

A day to never forget

As successful as Peter's season 2001 was, the highlight of the year came November 5th when Peter and Nathalie's daughter Gwen saw the light of day. Overwhelmed with emotions, the happiness came to an ultimate climax when the postman delivered a letter later that day, saying Peter's NL01-5149744 was officially acclaimed 1st National young acebird NPO 2001 ... No wonder she was called 'Gwen'.

meant a golden hit. Peter required two eggs from a 100% Koopman pair of Marcel and ringed one of them NL04-2057095 'Replay' ... a light chequer who developed as a beauty cockbird and caused a revolution in International pigeon sport.

In his first year of breeder, paired to 'Black 872', 'Replay' bred the absolute top performers 'Graz' (3x 1st and 9th NPO winner) and 'Amigo' (3x 1st and 9th Nat. racing cock) ... when paired to 'Pretty Woman' in 2006, direct children were 'Nathalie', winner of 1st NPO Chantilly from 30,074 birds and 'Pikeur', winner 1st prov. Ablis 40,268 birds. Also are direct children to 'Replay', who slowly grew out to become a phenomenon. Especially when also 4 different grandchildren won 1st NPO and even great grandchildren showed to win in massive competition. In the current racing team 'Replay' offspring plays a very dominant role. And now 'Replay' himself is aging, his son 'Replay Junior' easily takes over the role as super breeder, producing a/o a 1st NPO and 1st provincial winner.

With the dominance of 'Replay' combined to the old basic lines of Peter Van De Merwe, the number of NPO victories grew to an incredible number of eighteen (18!) at the end of the line, all won between 1991 and 2014. The ones one in the new Millennium are:

Fanciers racing for many years amongst the absolute top of International pigeon racing ... there are no more than a hand full of them. In this elite group Peter Van De Merwe holds a unique position. From start to finish he was amongst the very best in the country. A long list of references points out the impact of his strain of pigeons in England, Germany, Netherlands, Hungary, America, China, Taiwan, Japan - any place in the world – is enormous. It is fair to say Peter holds one of the most successful pigeon families in International pigeon racing, a life's work built up in 27 years and now auctioned exclusively on PIPA.

Most recently this was a sister to 'United', at Van Der Poel breeder of 2 generations 1. prize winners against 7,651 birds, 3,891 birds, 642 birds and 433 birds, but also 2. NPO 8,426 birds. Just to underline the elite in pigeon racing succeeds with Peter Van De Merwe pigeons.

Crehan O' Connor *(Salford, UK)*

Just recently John Crehan sold all his top racers and breeders in a spectacular sale in PIPA ... the world saw what this top fancier is up to and also how one of his supreme breeders was NL08-1545546 'Rosie', a direct child to Peter Van De Merwe's pair 'Bauer' x 'Graz'.
